Introduction







The work of "homogenising" the different profiles and updating the national one with the new needs expressed by the BUILD UP Skills-Italy roadmap has to be kept under control while, in parallel, the development of national standards for the different profiles will start within the WP6 activity. Besides it will be very important to identify, with the Regions (WP2: task 2.6), the criteria of Workers Qualification's Scheme in Building Refurbishment sector, focused on the Learning Outcome more than on a formal qualification scheme as it is important to find the solution for qualifying around one million of workers who are already employed in the building sector rather than set up only the qualification schema for the new

generation of workers. This last activity is strongly linked to the WP4 activity.

Overview







Task 3.1 Monitor the Regions' process for the national qualification framework

The aim of this task is to enter into the qualification process at national level.

It is important to start from the "Regions perspective" in order to develop national standards which do take into account their needs.

In consideration of the several existing professional profiles, an indepth recognition of them in three geographical perspectives (North, Central and South) represents the best way to report and to monitor the qualification framework.

Task 3.2 Set up a qualification scheme for today's workers aligned with the formal qualification scheme set up by the Regions

The aim of this task is the creation of a Building Refurbishment sector Workers Qualification's scheme based on a Web Application.

The partners will set up a Learning Outcome qualification Procedures's Handbook.

The activities for this task are:

- Identification of knowledge, skills and competences for each profile based on existing regional schemes;
- Definition of "Incidence and Value" for each knowledge/skills;
- Creation of Web Application;
- Web Application Test.

Task 3.3 Identify the good practices at regional, national and European level

The aim of this task is to avoid inventing the wheel again. This means that we will identify the experiences already available and create real link with them in order, not only to avoid duplication but also to create collaborations.

A data base, which will be freely available, with a "Minimum Data Set" will be available in the BUILD UP Skills BRICKS web site with the description of the main characteristics of the qualification scheme, the stakeholders, the "geographic implementation", other work needed to be implemented at national/European level. The database is mainly addressed to decision makers, VET centres, trainers, students and other end users. Besides we will monitor other projects eventually funded by EASME in the pillar two in order to create synergies and avoid duplications.

The activities for this task are:

- Analysis of existing regional and national schemas;
- Web data bases of existing good practices.

D 3.1 Web Application for workers' qualification requirements identification.

It will be a user friendly Web Application that will support the qualification process, at national level, for workers requirements recognition.

D 3.2 Learning Outcome qualification Procedures' Handbook.

This Handbook will contain all the procedures relating to workers' qualification Scheme, in order to have a first evaluation of the knowledge and the skills of each applicant.

D3.3 Data base of good practices to be endorsed by the BUILD UP Skills BRICKS project.

A data base will be realized, with a Minimum Data Set, available in the BUILD UP Skills BRICKS website that will contain the main qualification scheme elements and characteristics.
